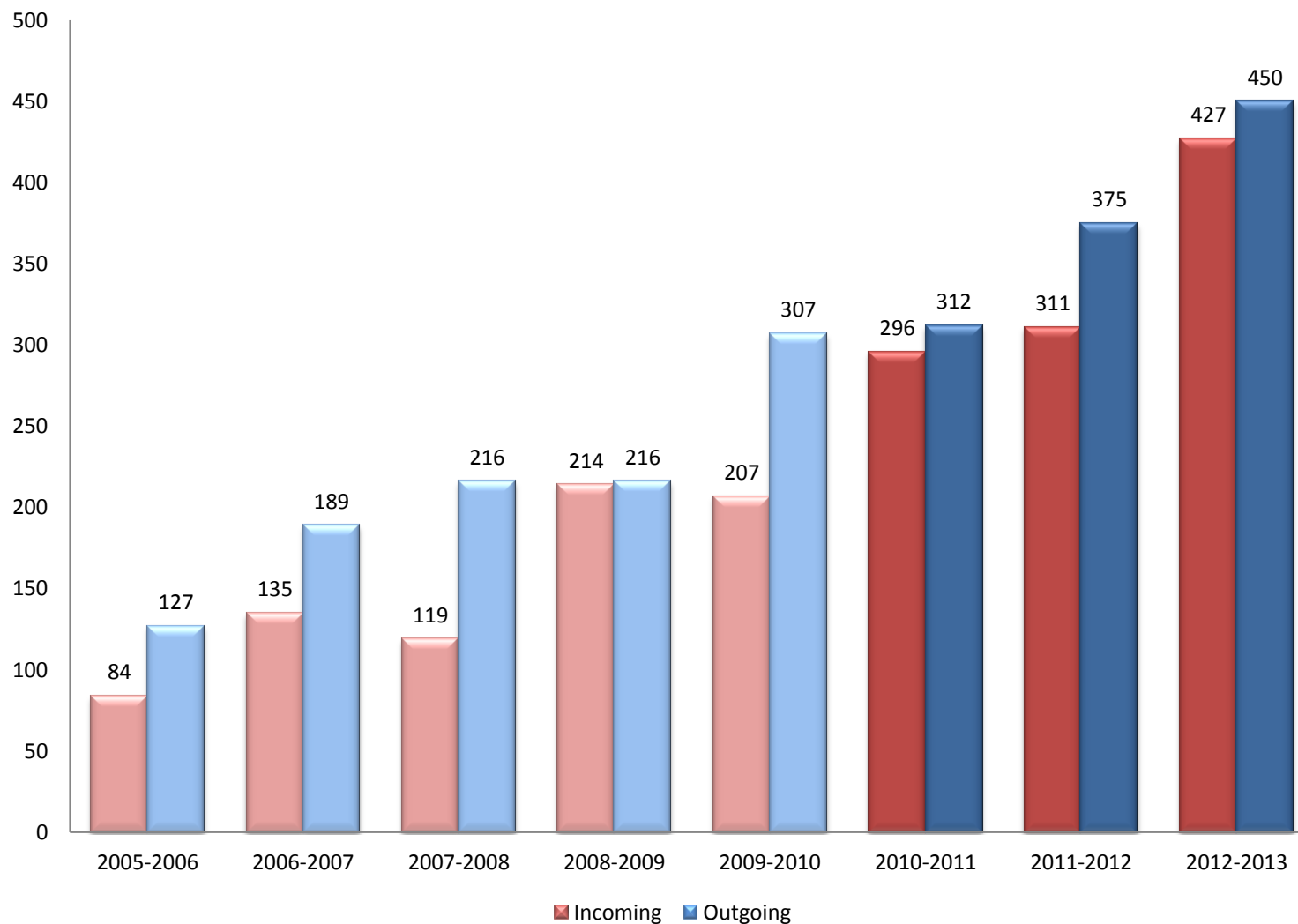


Number of Exchanges - Erasmus

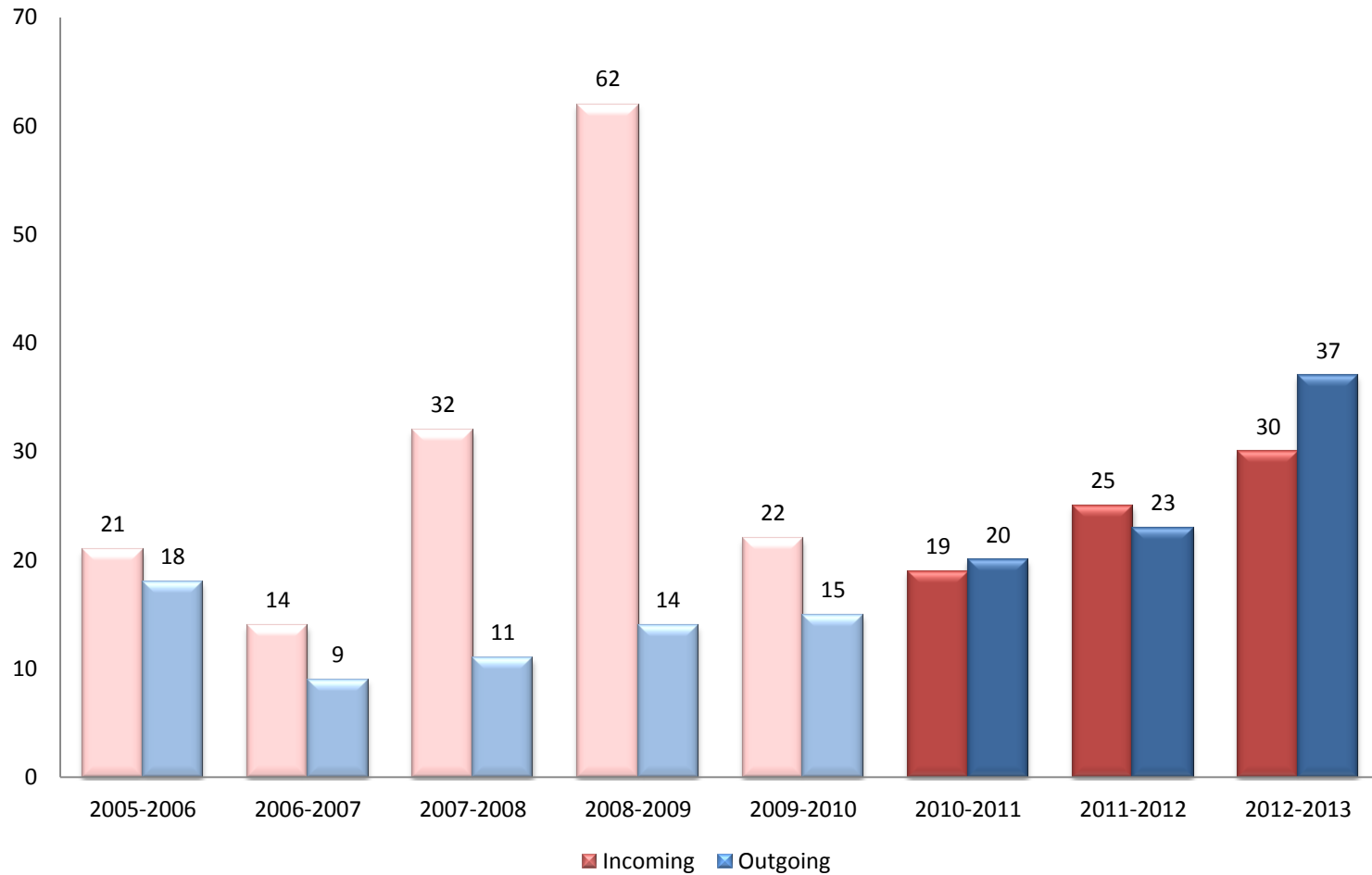

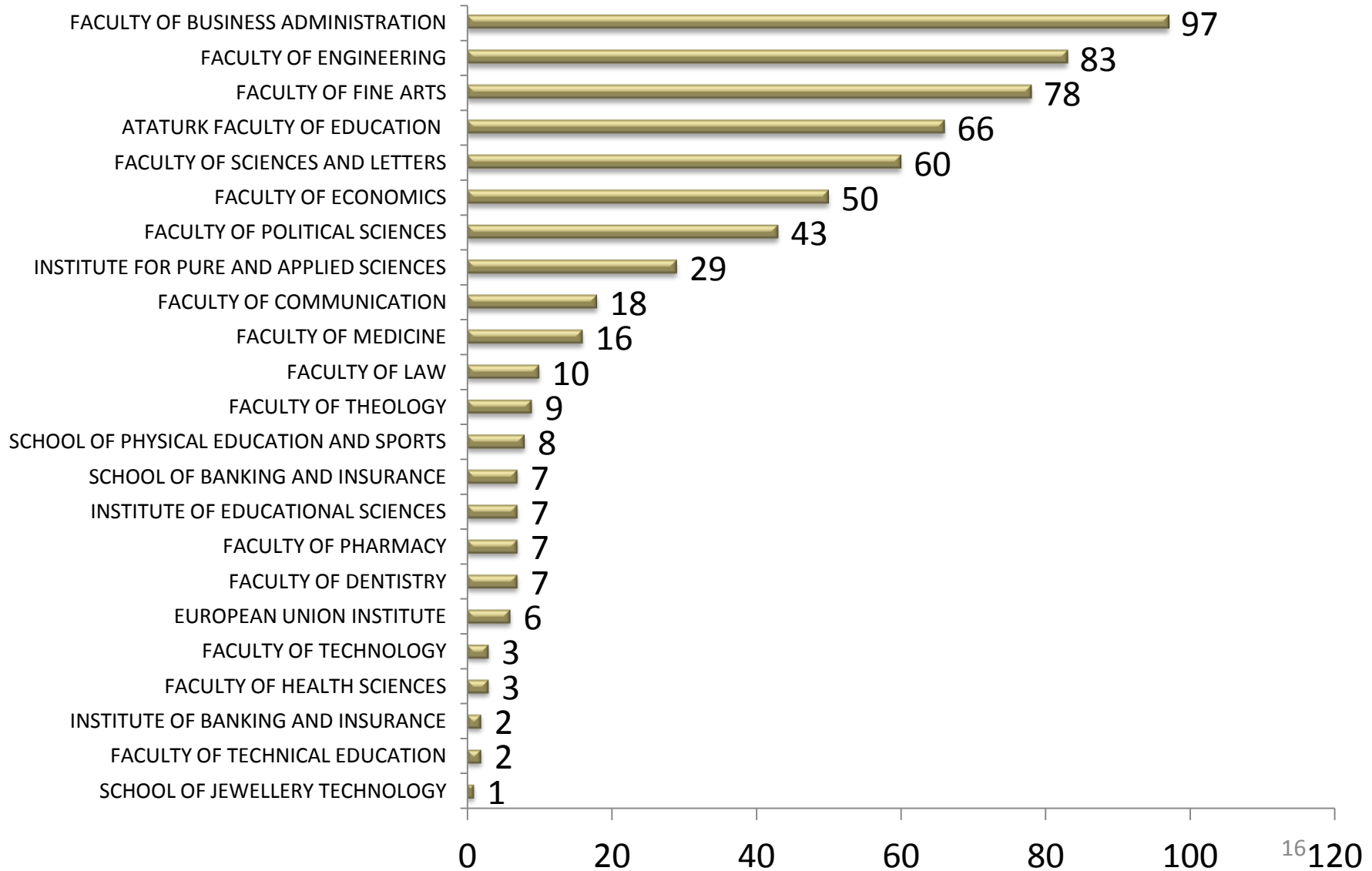

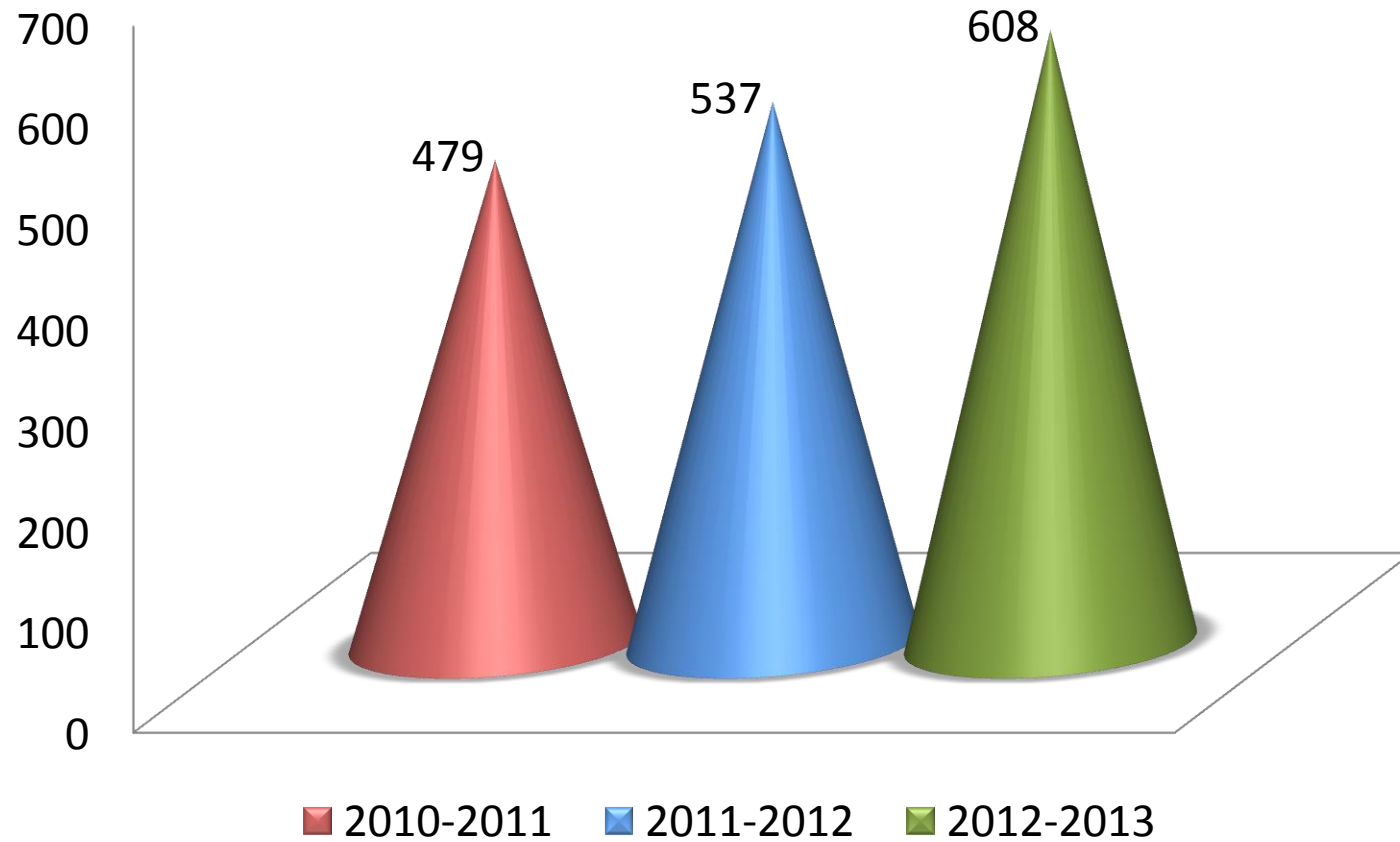




Erasmus Bilateral Agreements (612 in total)

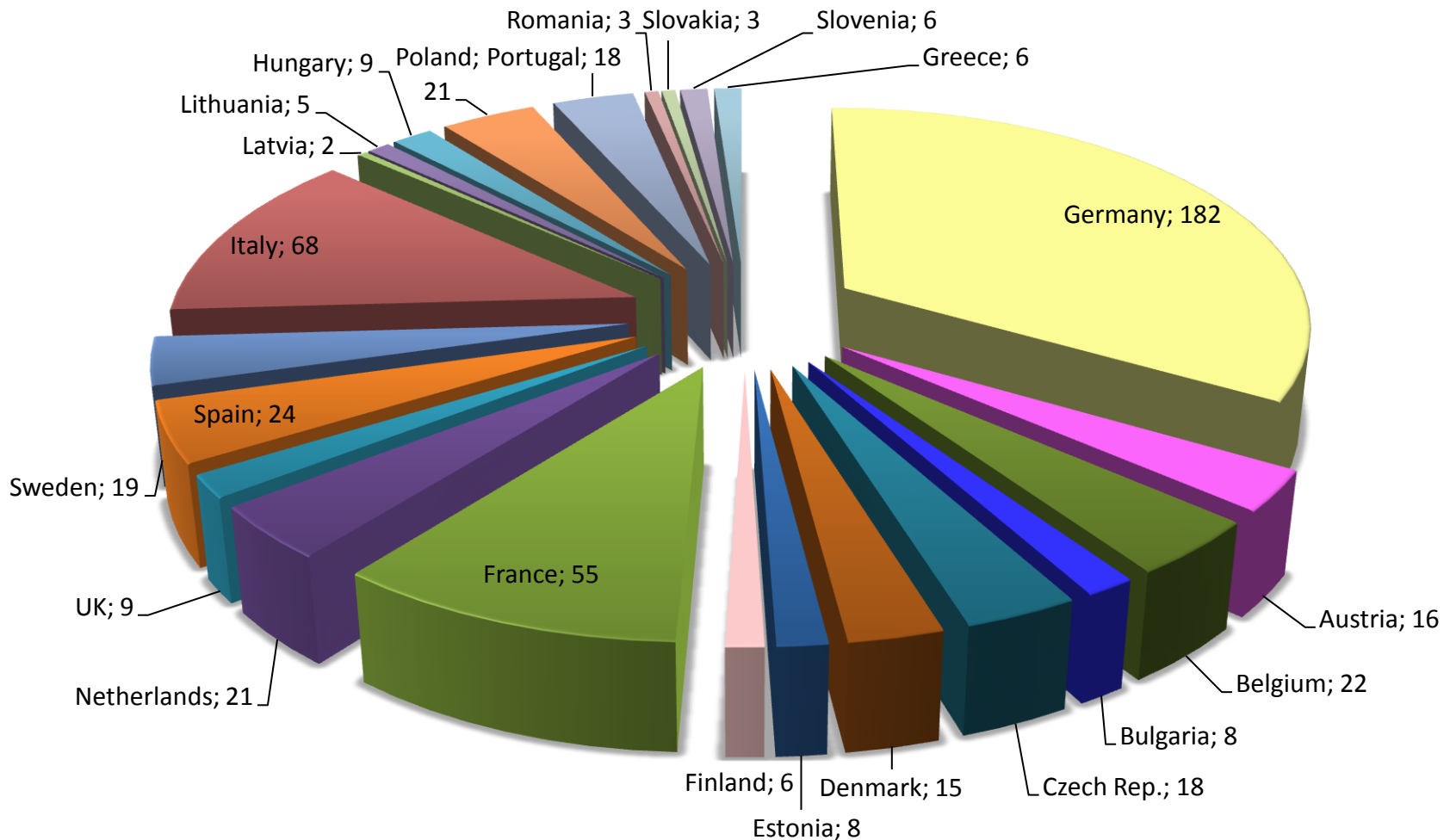

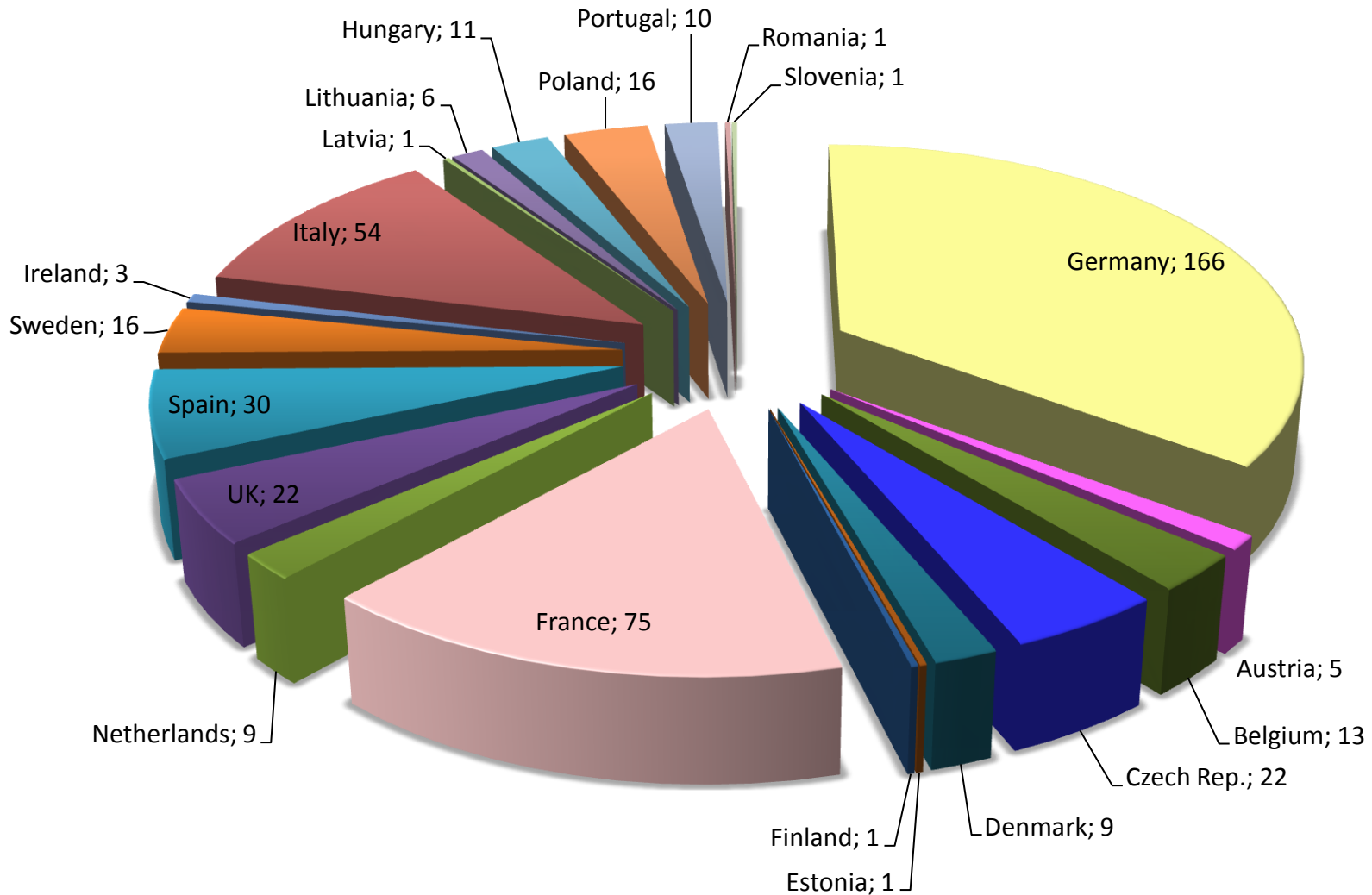

Outgoing (Staff, Student)

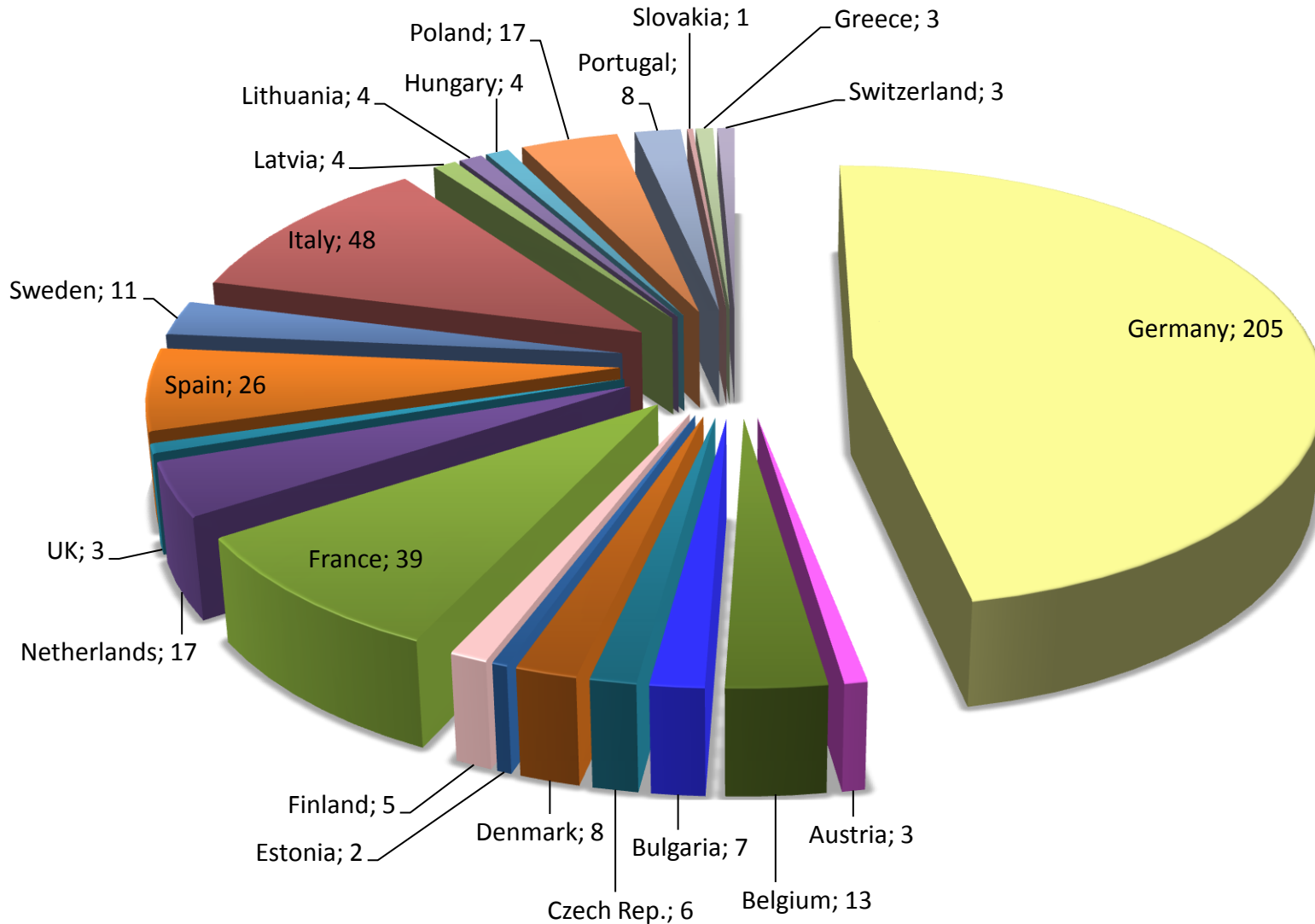

2000'li yılların başında resmi olarak AB Eğitim ve Gençlik Programları ile tanışan Türkiye geride kalan bu dönemde, gerek bütçe büyüklüğü gerekse yararlanıcı sayısı bakımından büyük bir yol kat ederek, 33 Avrupa ülkesi arasında 3. sıraya yükselmiştir.

Elde edilen başarının devamı ya da aşılması için gereken çalışmaların planlanması, paydaşların bilgilendirilmesi, sorunların tespit edilip çözümü konusunda görev

dağılımlarının yapılması gibi konuların tartışılacağı seminerler Türkiye'nin 7 bölgesinde KION TR tarafından **6 Ocak – 30 Haziran 2013** tarihleri arasında gerçekleştirilecek.

Marmara Bölgesinde faaliyet gösteren üniversite sayısının fazlalığı ve bölgedeki ulaşım gücü nedeniyle Avrupa ve Anadolu yakalarında ayrı ayrı düzenlenecek olan seminerlerin Anadolu ayağı, Marmara Üniversitesi Göztepe yerleşkesinde gerçekleştirilecektir. Marmara Üniversitesi ev sahipliğinde Nisan ayında gerçekleştirilecek olan seminere, Anadolu yakasında bulunan tüm üniversitelerimiz davet edilmişlerdir.

Hochschule Ravensburg-Weingarten

1. Hochschulkooperation mit Universität in Istanbul

Prof. Dr. Eberhard Hohl zeigte sich stolz nach seiner Rückkehr aus der 13 Millionen-Metropole Istanbul über die neue Errungenschaft. In seiner Funktion als Auslandsbeauftragter der Fakultät Technologie und Management gelang ihm nach intensiven Vorbereitungen, einen Kooperationsvertrag mit der traditionsreichen, renommierten Marmara University in Istanbul abzuschließen.

Als Wirtschaftshochschule 1883 gegründet, ist sie die zweitgrößte und einzige „multi-linguale“ Universität in der Türkei, an der in vier Sprachen (Türkisch, Deutsch, Englisch und Französisch) unterrichtet wird. Die erste Kooperation mit einer türkischen Hochschule passt in das Strategiekonzept seines internationalen Universitäts-Netzwerks in zukunftssträchtigen Regionen und Ländern, zu denen er auch die Türkei zählt. Professor Hohl erläutert, dass die Marmara Universität ein „Flagschiff“ in Bezug auf die bestehenden Kooperations-

programm für Studierende der Weingartner Hochschule und der türkischen Partnerhochschule.

Im Rahmen seines Besuchs war Professor Hohl beeindruckt von der Gastfreundschaft und der freundlich-aufgeschlossenen Art seiner türkischen Partner. Dr. Arzu Baloglu, Informatikprofessorin und Leiterin des Auslandsamts mit Sitz am größten Standort, dem Goztepe Campus auf der asiatischen Seite Istanbuls, zeigte sich hocherfreut über die neue Partnerschaft.

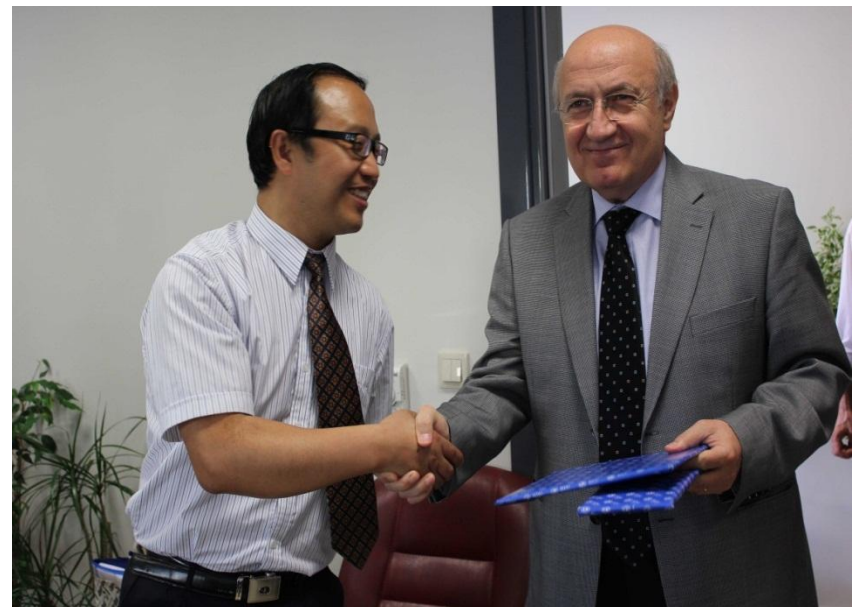
